Enclosed for filing in the above matter please find the *Direct Testimony of John D.* Warshaw and Christopher Green, with attached schedules, and the *Technical Statement of Tyler Culbertson and James M. King*, with attachments.

The Company asserts confidentiality pursuant to Puc 201.06(a)(15), as governed by the procedures described in Puc 201.06 and Puc 201.07.

The Company also requests a waiver of the requirement in Puc 1603.05(a)(1) to file clean and redlined versions of illustrative tariff pages because a key team member responsible for preparing the tariff pages has been out of the office for some time dealing with family medical issues, and the remaining team members have been fully occupied with other matters.

The Commission "shall waive the provisions of any of its rules ... if the commission finds that: (1) The waiver serves the public interest; and (2) the waiver will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the commission." Puc 201.05(a). When considering whether a waiver request serves the public interest, "the commission shall waive a rule if ... [t]he purpose of the rule would be satisfied by an alternative method proposed."
