Dear Chair Goldner:

On May 17, 2023, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. ("UES" or the "Company") submitted its proposed 2023 default service schedule for the six-month periods beginning August 1, 2023 and February 1, 2024. The Commission subsequently scheduled a hearing on the Company's default service proposal for the six months commencing August 1, 2023, but did not at that time schedule a hearing on proposal for the six-month period commencing February 1, 2023. That schedule remains unchanged, and is as follows:

- RFP Issued on October 31, 2023
- Indicative Bids due November 14, 2023
- Final Bids due November 28, 2023
- Default Service Filing to Commission on December 1, 2023
- Hearing Week of December 4, 2023
- Commission Order Requested December 8, 2023

UES requests that the Commission schedule a hearing on its upcoming default energy service solicitation consistent with the above schedule, i.e., during the week of December 4, 2023. The Company requests that the Commission issue an Order by **December 8, 2023**.
