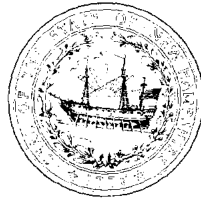

Re: DT 06-067 BayRing Communications Complaint
against Verizon New Hampshire's Access Charges
Revised Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On January 10, 2007, Verizon New Hampshire (Verizon) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in the above referenced matter in light of its concurrently filed motion to compel discovery. As set forth in Commission Order No. 24,705, dated November 29, 2006, initial discovery requests, of which several are subject to party objections as well as Verizon's pending motion to compel, are due Friday, January 12, 2007. On January 12, 2007, AT&T, One Communications, and BayRing Communications jointly filed a request to revise the procedural schedule in lieu of the indefinite suspension requested by Verizon. Staff and Verizon concurred in the proposed revisions to the schedule. The proposed revisions are based on an anticipated Commission decision date of February 1, 2007, regarding any pending motions to compel discovery.

The Commission has determined that the revised schedule will not unduly delay the proceeding or adversely affect the rights of any party. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule has been approved:

Objections/responses to motions to compel	January 22, 2007
Uncontested data responses due	January 22, 2007
Estimate of financial impact due from all parties	February 8, 2007
Additional discovery responses, if any, due (pursuant to Commission decision on pending motions to compel)	February 8, 2007
Prefiled testimony from all parties due	March 9, 2007
Discovery served on all parties	March 23, 2007
Discovery responses due from all parties	April 6, 2007
Rebuttal testimony due from all parties	April 20, 2007
Discovery served on all parties	May 4, 2007
Discovery responses due from all parties	May 18, 2007

If, for any reason, a decision on the pending motion to compel is not issued by February 1, 2007, the schedule will be revised accordingly.
