On March 18, 2008, C&W Communications LLC (C&W) and Verizon New Hampshire (Verizon) jointly filed a petition for approval of an Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) between Verizon and C&W pursuant to Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. §252(e).

On April 17, 2008, FairPoint Communications (FairPoint) filed a letter informing the Commission of FairPoint's assumption of existing Verizon Agreements following the March 31, 2008 transfer of landline assets and operations from Verizon to FairPoint. As a result, the Verizon-C&W Agreement is now a FairPoint-C&W Agreement.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC §252(e) (4), the Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.

Docket No. DT 08-043 has been assigned should future filings in this matter be required.
