When Pittsfield Aqueduct acquired Integrated Water Systems they indeed cut my bill by almost 50% & increased my water flow by at least that much, for which my family is truly grateful. We are not opposed to a rate increase but I believe I can speak for any of their customers when I say that 312% is totally ridiculous & uncalled for. I know of no community that pays over \$100.00 a month for about 4000 gallons of water. I see of no reason why the grants this company has applied for should not be approved everybody should have the right to clean affordable water service. As for the residents of Locke Lake paying a higher rate , how fair is this, all customers should pay the same rate.

With regard to the arsenic problem which was discovered after the purchase, Integrated Water Systems should have to pay the entire bill for the cleanup. It was their company who did not disclose the problem which I understand they knew about at the time of the sale. Aren't there laws about this kind of activity?

Higher prices on gas, heating oil, groceries etc have put a great strain on all of us. My wife & I like many other families struggle & live paycheck to paycheck and can not afford such a substantial rate increase!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

I am emailing you in regards to the water rates increase to us by Pittsfield Aqueduct Company. This increase is going to more than triple our water bill instantly. Very unfair to us as consumers with no warning about such a drastic change in our water bill so quickly. Why is this company getting no state or federal assistance to help keep up with required standards? My wife and I are both already disabled and struggling on SS-DI. I am epileptic and my wife has multiple sclerosis. I understand there should be some increase in our bill as this water company or any who own the system maintain it. But not such an incredible increase like this. Let's be a little more realistic about what consumers can afford for a water bill. I would rather have my own private well drilled first, but we don't own two building lots side by side which is required for us to have our own well. They want to increase our bill by 311.00% permanently. Give me a break. Our bill is currently between \$25.00 and \$30.00 on average. Why is this company looking for a permanent increase? Why not just till they can get paid back for improvements made to the system and then back to a normal rate? This company should get some state and federal financial funding or grants to help keep up with required standards. This is all being unfairly passed on to the end consumer permanently. After they collect for improvements made, it is all profit. Again, not fair at all. We were promised a decrease in the water rate from when Central Water Company was bought out. Dear Executive Director,

This letter is in regards to the Pittsfield Aqueduct Co., Inc. (PAC) petition to the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission to increase the PAC residential general metered customers. I've been a home owner of Locke Lake Colony since 1985, and have seen positive changes and improvements to the water system since Pennichuck Corporation purchased the previous water company. Unfortunately, the timing for this increase is terrible. My family can not afford such a substantial increase and we are requesting that the proposed rate increase be denied.

The state of our economy and all the issues related to fuel costs, gas for our vehicles, food, heat, families losing their homes, foreclosures the highest ever, unemployment, and of course tax increases. Recently I was laid off, which now I clearly understand what it means to be on a fixed income. Right at this moment my family can not afford an increase in water rates. Like thousands of others, and we all need some support and a little less financial pressure. These are my reasons why I am asking you to deny the rate increase as it is documented.

What I wish to propose in fairness to the Pittsfield Aqueduct Company (PAC) is continue to seek grants and low cost capital through both the State and Federal Government in order to keep the water rates as low as possible. At the same time, develop a increase plan raising the rates in smaller percentages over a five year period. Also, insure all rates are the same, we all pay for exactly what we use, therefore, seasonal families of Locke Lake Colony pay the exact same rates as those who live there year round and only pay for what they use.

Again, the proposed monthly increase is substantial and financially will have severe impact on my family I simply can not afford such an increase.
