Affiliate Agreement with Granite State Internet

Dear Mr. Coolbroth:

On May 2, 2008, Granite State Telephone, Inc. (GST) filed an amended affiliate agreement with Granite State Long Distance, Inc., d/b/a Granite State Internet (GSN). GST stated that the amended agreement supersedes and replaces an agreement filed with the Commission on April 22, 2008. According to the agreement, GST will provide GSN with administrative, technical, and network services based on applicable rules and regulations for affiliate agreements. The agreement has a term of two years, commencing April 14, 2008, and continues year to year thereafter unless terminated by either party.

This letter serves as an acknowledgement that [Company], pursuant to the requirements of RSA 366:3, has filed a contract between a public utility and an affiliate for the provision of services in exchange for compensation that exceeds \$500. This acknowledgement does not constitute approval of any rate or revenue requirement change that may be claimed as a result of the service provided for in the filed documents. As any issue that may arise under the contract may be addressed in another docket or through the opening of a new docket, the Commission will not open an investigation at this time under RSA 366:5 and has closed this docket. As you may be aware, any modifications of the contract must also be filed with the Commission pursuant to RSA 366:3.
