Motion for Confidential Treatment

Dear Ms. Hassen:

On May 27, 2008, you filed with the Commission on behalf of BayRing Communications a request for confidential treatment of certain material submitted in the above-captioned proceeding. Pursuant to RSA 378:43, II, in order to obtain confidential treatment, a telephone utility must represent to the Commission that the designated information or records "are not general public knowledge or published elsewhere; that measures have been taken by the telephone utility to prevent dissemination of the information or records in the ordinary course of business, and that the information or records: (a) pertain to the provision of competitive services; or (b) set forth trade secrets that required significant effort and cost to produce," etc. (The statute is available on the PUC homepage at: www.puc.nh.gov).

Staff has reviewed the company's filing and, inasmuch as the filing makes the requisite representations, the pertinent information or records will be afforded confidential treatment. However, pursuant to RSA 378:43, III, and subject to the telephone utility's right to request reconsideration, the Commission may, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, require disclosure.
