Part 2003.01(e) of the New Hampshire Code Admin. Rules Chapter PUC 2000, requires suppliers to annually adjust the security amount when it is based on gross receipts, and excluding revenues from the provision of transition and default service. Gexa Energy's gross receipts in New Hampshire for 2008 were \$0, thus the guaranty amount for the security should remain unchanged.
