Re: DW 08-086 Eastman Sewer Company Temporary Rate Recoupment and Rate Case Expenditures Surcharge

Dear Mr. Naylor:

In PUC Order #24,989 dated July 24, 2009 approving permanent rates, the Commission ordered that the Company "is authorized to recover from all customers the difference between its temporary and permanent rates, subject to the submission of documentation on recoupment … and … shall file its accounting of rate case expenses for the temporary and permanent rate phases of this proceeding…"

Attached are a temporary rate recoupment, rate case expenditures and proposed surcharge schedules. The temporary rate recoupment schedule shows the temporary rates, permanent rates and the difference. The temporary rates were utilized for three quarters. The quarterly difference times the three quarters amount to the total difference. The total difference times the number of customers represents the total temporary / permanent amount. The total temporary / permanent amount is \$4,755.09.

The rate case expenditure schedule shows the date of invoice, period, vendor/supplier and the amount. In those instances where only a portion of the invoice pertains to the rate case, the hour, rate/hour and amount are shown. The total rate case expenditures are \$18,331.50.

The proposed surcharge ... schedule shows the total temp/perm rate recoupment, the total rate case expenditures and the total subject to the proposed surcharge. The Company has 535 customers. The total proposed surcharge per customer is \$43.15. The Company proposes to recover the proposed surcharge over four quarters at a rate of \$10.79.

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The Company respectfully requests that the Staff review the schedules, the supporting documentation and the proposed surcharge. Please note that the supporting documentation, i.e., invoices, is being mailed separately. Once reviewed, please offer Staff's recommendation for review and consideration by the Company. The Company respectfully requests that the Staff review and make its recommendation in such time as to allow the PUC to issue an order by mid September 2009 so that the Company can add the surcharge to customer bills at the next schedule billing, September 15, 2009.
