On September 3, 2008, a duly noticed Prehearing Conference was held in the above referenced proceeding. Appearances at the Prehearing Conference were entered by representatives of Hampstead Area Water Company, Inc. (HAWC), John M. Wolters, *pro se*, the Office of the Consumer Advocate (participating as a full statutory party), and Commission Staff.

The Commission has determined that the proposed schedule is in the public interest and therefore has approved it. The Commission has also granted the intervention requests of Carol A Grant and John M. Wolters which are consistent with the applicable standards for intervention in that they have an interest as citizens of Atkinson that may be affected by the extension of the franchise in Atkinson. Finally, the Commission has deferred ruling on the Office of the Consumer Advocate's August 7, 2008 motion to consolidate the issue of HAWC's request for a step increase with Docket No. DW 08-065, HAWC's petition for an increase in permanent rates, pending receipt of the information that was requested of the Department of Environmental Services by Staff on September 4, 2008.

For administrative efficiency, the Commission has elected to issue this Secretarial Letter as its prehearing order in this proceeding.
