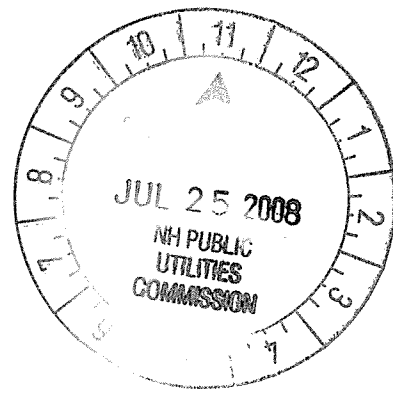

The registration application, together with an electronic copy on diskette, pursuant to Puc 202, shall be filed with the Executive Director and Secretary of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission). Any omissions and/or deficiencies which need to be corrected will be completed in a timely manner or the Commission may close this proceeding without prejudice.

NOTE: When completing this application electronically, using the "tab" key after completing each answer will move the cursor to the next blank to be filled in. Please note that there are certain attachments to be included with this application.

13. Payment of a filing fee of \$250.00.


**NOTE:**

- Any municipal entity that acts as an aggregator for its citizens shall NOT be required to pay a registration fee.
- Unless additional time is required to review the application and the Commission extends the review period, an aggregator may begin operating within the state 45 days after filing a completed notice of intent with the commission.
- Each aggregator shall re-file with the Commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date, which is the date on which the Commission received the applicant's initial notice of intent.
- There is NO re-registration fee provided that the re-filing is made in a timely manner.

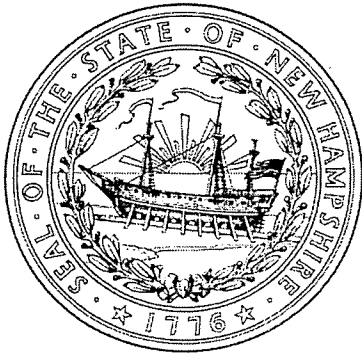
