Dear Ms. Howland:

The above-referenced Order states that "the Commission has jurisdiction over the Warner Village District and the District shall not discontinue water service to the Petitioners without Commission authorization." At this time we would like to request permission from the Commission to discontinue water service to the petitioners and one additional customer, as listed:

Peter and Rhonda St. James 69 North Village Road Warner NH 03278

Kenneth and Connie Benward 3 Waldron Hill Road Warner NH 03278

Deborah Buckley and James VonVett 92 North Village Road Warner NH 03278

Richard Fisher 84 North Village Rod Warner NH 03278

The main reasons for discontinuing water service to the above-mentioned customers is that the District has to waste a large amount of water each year just to keep that line clear; and the cost of repairs to the old water line will be prohibitive for the number of people on the line. The District proposes to install individual wells and has communicated this plan to the four property owners. All parties, the customers and the District, are in agreement with the District's plan to replace the existing water source with wells. Termination of District water would not happen until the four customers have accepted the new source of water and signed off on any further demands upon the District. The water from each well would receive a State water quality test and the results would be a part of the individual property owner's acceptance of the new well.

The projected date for the installation of the wells is 2010. The District has begun budgeting for the project, spreading the cost over a three-year period. We wish to know the disposition of the Commission on this proposal now so that we can continue to budget for the expense.
