I am writing to update the Commission as to the above Docket. On February 11, 2010, the District requested that the docket not be closed. On May 7, 2010 District Commissioner Savlen requested by telephone to Richard Schofield that he send the application for a waiver form for the Buckley and Benward property to continue the compliance process. Mr. Schofield responded by letter dated May 10, 2010 with the form requested and a list of action items for the District to complete.
