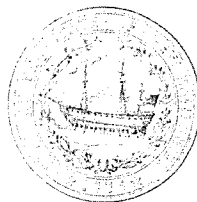

Dear Commissioners:

This docket was opened in July 2008 to consider the request of the District to discontinue water service to certain customers and to modify the District's franchise boundaries. The last communication from the District was a letter dated July 13, 2011, requesting the Commission keep this docket open, as the District was working through a waiver process with the Department of Environmental Services (DES). In December of 2011 the Commission was copied on a letter the District sent to DES, which contained additional information that DES was seeking. There has been no communication on this matter since that time.

I am writing to request that you provide the Commission with an update as to whether the District still seeks to discontinue water service to certain customers and to modify its franchise boundaries.
