Dear Commission Members:

At its meeting on April 17, 2009, the Joint Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules (Committee) voted, pursuant to RSA 541-A:13, V(a), to conditionally approve Final Proposal 2008-219 of the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) containing Puc 402.49 and Puc 431.01 relative to telecommunication. The Committee's approval was conditioned on amending the rules as specified in the Commission's conditional approval request of April 15, 2009, with the exception of the amendment to Puc 402.49, which was already made in the Final Proposal. A copy of the request is enclosed for your information.

Pursuant to RSA 541-A:13, V(a), you are required to submit a written explanation detailing how the rules have been amended in accordance with the conditional approval within 7 days following the Commission's next regularly scheduled meeting. It is our understanding that the Commission's next meeting is scheduled for May 1, 2009. In that case, you would have to respond by May 8, 2009. The explanation shall include a letter and a text of all the final proposed rules in Final Proposal 2008-219, annotated to show the changes made in the response.

The explanation shall be reviewed by the Office of Legislative Services to determine whether the rules have been amended in accordance with the conditional approval and RSA 541-A:13, V(a). If it is determined that the rules have not been amended in accordance with the conditional approval and RSA 541-A:13, V(a), the conditional approval shall be deemed a Committee vote to make a preliminary objection as of the date of the conditional approval, and you must respond to the preliminary objection as specified in RSA 541-A:13, V(c).

Please be advised that you may not adopt the rule until the Office of Legislative Services sends written confirmation that your amendment is in accordance with the conditional approval and RSA 541-A:13, V(a).

CHAPTER Puc 400 RULES FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS

PART Puc 402 DEFINITIONS

Readopt with Amendment Puc 402.49, effective 5-10-05 (Document #8348) to read as follows:

Puc 402.49 "Significant service outage" means outages in New Hampshire that affect:

- (a) An entire exchange;
- (b) All customers in a similar manner, such as interconnection failures;
- (c) 250 or more access lines and last more than 30 minutes;
- (d) 5000 or more access lines; or
- (e) Signaling system or tandem failures having a statewide impact; or
 - (ef) In the case of a CLEC, the majority of customers in a particular area.

PART Puc 431 CLEC REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

Readopt with Amendment Puc 431.01, effective 5-10-05 (Document #8348) to read as follows:

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(e) A CLEC authorized prior to the effective date of these rules shall use the commission's order

(f) Any authorization number obtained by a CLEC under this part shall be non-transferable.

number granting it authority to operate as a CLEC as its authorization number.
