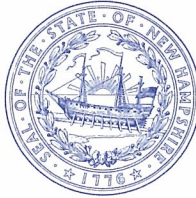

Dear Ms. Howland:

Following communications between Staff and the Company, a stipulation on temporary rates in the Company's pending rate case has been reached. The stipulation accompanies this letter. In brief, the stipulation provides that the Company's current rates will serve as temporary rates during the rate case. The intervenors are not parties to the stipulation and are not bound by it.

A hearing on the Company's temporary rates is scheduled for Friday, May 1, 2009. As such, pursuant to Puc 203.20 (f), we request that the Commission accept this late-filed stipulation as it promotes the orderly and efficient conduct of the proceeding and will not impair the rights of any party to the proceeding.
