DG 09-038, Order 25,039: Deferred Revenue Surcharge Reconciliation

Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed please find an original and two copies of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's final reconciliation of the deferred revenue surcharge.

Pursuant to Order 25,039 Approving Permanent Rate Increase in Docket DG 09-038, the Company was authorized to implement a deferred revenue surcharge on November 1, 2012. The purpose of the surcharge was to collect over a two year period the difference between the amounts that would have been collected under maximum delivery rates in first two years of the rate agreement and the actual amounts billed to customers under the phased-in rates. The surcharge ended on October 31, 2014, and the residual over-collected balance of \$3,045 will be refunded to customers through the monthly COG reconciliation for November 2014.
