To the Parties:

On December 1, 2009 Comcast Phone of New Hampshire, LLC (Comcast) filed a Motion for Enlargement of Time for filing Simultaneous Reply Testimony in the above referenced matter. The deadline for filing is December 2, 2009. Comcast states in its motion that an additional two days is needed to complete its Reply Testimony. Comcast sought concurrence with Time Warner Cable Digital Phone, New England Cable and Telecommunications Association, New Hampshire Telephone Association, the Office of Consumer Advocate and Commission Staff which indicated no objection to the extension. The remaining parties have not responded with their position.

The Commission has determined that extending the deadline in which to file Simultaneous Reply Testimony will not unduly delay the proceeding or adversely affect the rights of any party. Accordingly, the deadline for submission of Reply Testimony has been extended to December 4, 2009.
