OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request 1-2 on the grounds that it is overbroad, unduly burdensome and not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Subject to and without waiving these objections, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-2.

## RESPONSE:

a. Each entity is required to be qualified to engage in business in New Hampshire as a domestic or foreign corporation. Each ILEC is required to secure a franchise pursuant to RSA 374:22. Hollis Telephone Company, Inc. and Wilton Telephone Company, Inc. have reduced regulation pursuant to approved alternative regulation plans. The other ILECs are subject to full rate of return regulation. US Cellular provides wireless communications services. Granite State Long Distance, Inc. and TDS Long Distance Corporation are registered as competitive toll providers. MCT Communications, Inc. is a cable television provider with franchise agreements in various communities and subject to applicable state and federal regulation. The ILECs, the long distance companies and US Cellular also hold permits from the Federal Communications Commission.
b. Most of the regulated services offered by the identified entities are set forth in tariffs and special contracts on file with the Commission and FCC. Non-regulated and detariffed services provided include CPE, inside wiring, Internet access, and billing and collection services. The long distance companies offer service in
accordance with price lists on file with the NHPUC and posted on their websites. MCT Communications, Inc. provides basic and premium cable television services. US Cellular provides wireless communication services subject to regulation by the FCC. Granite State Telephone, Inc. provides local, long distance and access services in accordance with its tariffs on file with the Commission. Granite State Long Distance, Inc. has two divisions, the first of which provides retail long distance service; the second provides internet access and web hosting/design services. Granite State Telephone Service Corporation has two divisions, the first of which provides rating and billing services for telephone companies; the second leases vehicles.

d. Universal Service funds are not allocated on an individual service basis. Instead, as the Commission certified to the FCC in September 2008, all of the amounts listed in response to request Comcast 1-2.c were spent for the provision, maintenance and upgrade of facilities and services for which support is intended under Section 254 of the Communications Act. This support is intended to preserve the Petitioners' ability to act as the carriers of last resort (or as an Eligible Telephone Carrier, in the case of US Cellular).

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e. Data on the relative percentages of these services is not produced in the normal course of business and is not available without an unduly burdensome effort.

Douglas Meredith is responsible for this response.

COMCAST 1-3: Please state the basis for the statement contained in paragraph 2 of the Petition that Petitioners "face wireless and computer based nomadic voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") competition in New Hampshire," including identification of:
a. each entity that Petitioners contend offers such "competition";
b. each service provided by each such entity that Petitioners contend constitutes "competition" with a service offered by Petitioners; and
c. each service offered by each Petitioner that Petitioners contend "face...competition" from the entities identified.

OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request 1-3 on the grounds that it is overbroad, unduly burdensome and not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Subject to and without waiving these objections, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-3.

## RESPONSE:

a. The Petitioners face competition from many carriers, primarily including the following:

1. ATT/Cingular Wireless - Voice and Data
2. Verizon Wireless - Voice and Data
3. Sprint/ Nextel - Voice and Data
4. T-Mobile - Voice
5. Tracfone Wireless - Voice
6. U.S. Cellular - Voice and Data
7. In addition, all of the Petitioners offer a broadband Internet service that is capable of supporting "Over the Top" VoIP providers (e.g. Vonage) that do not offer transmission but only need an end user's broadband connection. New Hampshire customers can obtain service from any of these companies.

As an illustration, representative copies of advertising materials for these carriers are provided in Exhibit Comcast 1-3(a), attached. This Exhibit also contains a report of the availability of various "Over the Top" VoIP providers.
b. Sprint, Verizon Wireless, ATT wireless, Sprint/NexTel all compete with the Petitioners for local voice, long distance voice, and data services. Riding on top of an end user's broadband Internet connection, including cable modem service provided by Comcast, Metrocast, Time Warner, etc., the VoIP providers compete with the petitioners for local voice and long distance service. Tracfone even offers a free calling service known as

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SafeLink for low income users that competes with the Lifeline and Link-Up services provided by the Petitioners. (See Exhibit Comcast 1-3(b)). According to an article published in the Manchester Union Leader on July 15, 2009 (the text of which is included in Exhibit 1-3(b)), Tracfone reported that over 100,000 households in New Hampshire qualify for Lifeline service.
c. Services for which the Petitioners face competition include residential local calling, single and multi-line business local calling, domestic and international long distance calling, as well as features such as call waiting, call forwarding, caller ID, 3-Way calling, voicemail, etc. The data services provided by ATT, Sprint, and Verizon compete with the Petitioners' DSL service.

COMCAST 1-4: Please state the basis for the statement contained in paragraph 7 of the Petition that Comcast's provision of telecommunications services to its affiliates as a competitive local exchange carrier is "a result not contemplated by the Telecommunications Act of 1996." Please provide the citation(s) to the specific provision(s) in the Telecommunications Act of 1996 upon which you rely in support of this statement and provide copies of all documents and identify all sources of information that support this statement.

OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request 1-4 on the grounds that it seeks a legal conclusion. Subject to and without waiving this objection, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-4.

## RESPONSE:

The lack of guidance in the Telecommunications Act is most clearly reflected in the FCC's 2004 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NPRM") regarding IP-enabled service, in which it struggles throughout with the tension between the deregulatory approach to information services and the regulatory approach to voice services. This is best exemplified in paragraph 42 of the NPRM, in which the FCC describes the public policy goals of the Act and the extent to which the Act "does not prescribe a particular regulatory treatment" in regard to "VoIP and other IP-enabled services."

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COMCAST 1-5: $\quad$ Please state the basis for the statements contained in paragraphs 8 and 14 of the Petition that Comcast provides "identical services" to those provided by Petitioners, including identification of each service provided by Comcast that you contend is "identical" to a service provided by any Petitioner, and identification of each service provided by each Petitioner that you claim is "identical" to a service provided by Comcast. Provide copies of all documents and identify all sources of information that support those statements.

OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request $1-5$ on the grounds that it is overbroad, unduly burdensome and not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Subject to and without waiving these objections, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-5.

## RESPONSE:

Comcast provides local and long distance services that it markets as identical in basic functionality as those provided by Petitioners. Like the Petitioners, Comcast also provides ancillary features such as call forwarding, call waiting, speed dial, and call management service. Furthermore, Comcast competes against the Petitioners for access services, as evidenced by Comcast's New Hampshire Access Services Guide. ${ }^{2}$

Attached as Exhibit Comcast 1-5 are copies of some of the pages from the Comcast website that state that its services function as identical substitutes for services offered by the Petitioners. Comcast also publishes a Fact Sheet ("Reinventing Residential Phone Service for the 21st Century") ${ }^{3}$ that asserts that "Comcast Digital Voice is an innovative and reliable IP-enabled home phone service that delivers all of the functions of traditional phone service. (Emphasis supplied).

In a 2008 Comcast Press Release ("Move Over Bells: Comcast Corporation Becomes The Fourth-Largest Phone Service Provider In The U.S.") ${ }^{4}$ Comcast stated that as of January 8, 2008, it was "the fourth-largest residential phone service provider in the United States." In this Press Release, Comcast Digital Voice service is described as a "true home phone replacement service" and "the fastest-growing home phone service in the country." Furthermore, it states that, as of January 8, 2008, "Comcast Business Class Digital Voice is now widely available to small businesses." This Press Release was followed by one on March 11, 2009 ("Comcast Now the Third Largest Residential Phone Services Provider in the U.S.") ${ }^{5}$ stating that Comcast has moved up in the rankings and is now "the third-largest residential phone service provider in the country"

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and "continues to compete for customers and remains a new entrant into a market that is dominated by legacy providers AT\&T, Verizon and Qwest."

Valerie Wimer is responsible for this response.

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COMCAST 1-6: Please state the basis for the statement contained in paragraph 11 of the Petition that the "RLECS believe" that "there is no net change in protocol" when Comcast carries a "call that involves an RLEC customer on one end and a Comcast Digital Voice customer on the other end." Please provide the factual basis for these statements and provide copies of all documents and identify all sources of information that support these statements. In particular, and in addition, describe Petitioners' understanding of the end points of Comcast's network.

## RESPONSE:

The Petitioners have stated their belief, based on their current understanding of the Comcast Digital Voice service, that there is no net change in protocol. Documents and other factual information supporting this belief reside with Comcast itself and have been requested pursuant to the Petitioners' Data Requests to Comcast, particularly Data Requests 6-10 and 23-28.

Valerie Wimer is responsible for this response.

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COMCAST 1-7: For each of the services Petitioners provide, please state your understanding of the end points of Petitioners' network(s).

## RESPONSE:

The Petitioners network ends at the last point closest to the customer that the Petitioner owns or directly controls. Typically, this element is the Network Interface Device. When interfacing with a carrier the Petitioner's network is at the meet point with the other carrier. That point is identified in the actual service order for the service between the two carriers.

Valerie Wimer is responsible for this response.

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COMCAST 1-8: Please define with specificity the term "IP enabled voice service" as it is used in paragraph 13 of the Petition, in which Petitioners request that the Commission "determine the appropriate regulatory treatment of IP enabled voice service."

OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request $1-8$ on the grounds that it seeks a legal conclusion. Subject to and without waiving this objection, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-8.

## RESPONSE:

IP enabled voice service is synonymous with "Voice over IP," which is any IP-enabled, realtime, multidirectional voice call, including, but not limited to, service that mimics traditional telephony. ${ }^{6}$

IP-enabled voice service includes:
(i) Voice traffic originating on a carrier's network as IP packets ("Internet Protocol Connection" or "IPC"), and which terminates on the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN); and
(ii) Voice traffic originated on the PSTN, and which terminates as an IPC.

Douglas Meredith and Valerie Wimer are responsible for this response.

[^2]COMCAST 1-9: Please state the basis for the statement contained in paragraph 14 of the Petition that "alternative regulation is unavailable to almost all of the RLECs," including identification of each Petitioner for whom you contend such alternative regulation is unavailable, each Petitioner for whom you concede such alternative regulation is available, and the reasons therefor. Provide copies of all documents and identify all sources of information that support those statements.

OBJECTION: NHTA objects to Data Request $1-9$ on the grounds that it is overbroad, unduly burdensome and not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Subject to and without waiving these objections, NHTA will provide information responsive to Data Request 1-9.

## RESPONSE:

A long history of events shows that pursuing alternative regulation is not practical for ILECs in New Hampshire.

- Kearsarge Telephone Company pursued a lengthy and expensive alternative regulation case docketed as DT 01-221. After nearly two and a half years that included a full rate investigation and active opposition from the Office of Consumer Advocate and the Staff, the request was denied. See Order No. 24,281 dated February 20, 2004 and Order No. 24,307 dated April 12, 2004. Filings in this Docket are available at the Commission.
- In 2004, NHTA participated in the rulemaking process for the re-adoption of the Commission's alternative regulation rules. In this process, NHTA pointed out that the Commission's rules, which were applicable to all utilities, were not suitable for the telecommunications industry. NHTA drafted for the Commission's consideration and adoption proposed rules for alternative regulation plans for small ILECs. The Commission declined to take action on these rules. The filings in this regard are available at the Commission.
- With its rulemaking proposal having been rejected, NHTA sought legislative relief in the 2005 legislative session in the form of an amendment to HB 194 to authorize alternative regulation plans for small ILECs. The legislation that was approved, following participation by the Commission and the opposition of the OCA, included language (absolute price caps without exceptions for exogenous factors) that made the legislation unusable. The legislative history is available in the State Archives.
- Following the 2005 session, NHTA participated in the study committee process established in HB 194. The study committee considered input from a number of parties
and concluded that technical changes should be made to RSA 374:3-b and that small ILECs should be encouraged to seek alternative regulation. In the 2006 legislative session, the Legislature approved the study committee recommendations through the enactment of HB 1756. The legislative history is available in the State Archives.
- In 2006, Verizon New England Inc., d/b/a Verizon New Hampshire ("Verizon") negotiated an agreement with the Staff and sought approval of the negotiated alternative regulation plan in Docket DT 06-072. Following active opposition by the OCA and clients of New Hampshire Legal Assistance, Verizon withdrew its request. Subsequently, Verizon sold its ILEC business and properties in New Hampshire. Filings in this Docket are available at the Commission.
- On March 1, 2007, the four TDS companies filed their petitions seeking alternative regulation in Docket DT 07-072. The Staff and intervenors have proposed, and in some respects the Commission has adopted, restrictive views regarding eligibility of alternative regulation plans for approval. The result is that with well over two years having passed since the filing of the petitions and major concessions having been made by the TDS companies, plans have been approved for only the two small one-exchange companies.
- In response to the statutory interpretation given to RSA 374:3-b in Order No. 24,852, NHTA sought new legislation in the 2009 legislative session in the form of HB 413. Again, following major concessions in an effort to generate support for the legislation, language proposed by Comcast (apparently designed to hinder the small ILECs business and enhance Comcast's competitive position) was interjected into the process, and NHTA requested that the sponsors kill the bill. HB 413 is available online. Comcast already has copies of its proposed language.

In the meantime, many of New Hampshire's small ILECs are operating their intrastate regulated businesses at a loss (even after the application of USF funds to the regulated business), and it appears that Comcast is preparing to leverage its monopoly cable television position and its vast resources to take telephone business from the small ILECs, while maintaining that small ILECs should remain under full rate of return regulation.

## New Hampshire Union Leader

MANCHESTER -- Certain low-income households in New Hampshire are now eligible for free cell phones, and 66 free minutes a month, through a government-backed program.

TracFone Wireless, a major company of prepaid cell phones, recently launched its SafeLink Wireless service in the state.

The company said it is the first and only completely free offering of Lifeline, a program supported by the Federal Communications Commission for eligible low-income households.

The FCC has traditionally provided services to give low-income households in the form of a discount on monthly telephone bills.

Lifeline is not funded through federal taxpayer money, but from contributions to the "Universal Service Fund," which telecommunications carriers collect in part from the charge billed to cell phone customers.

More than 100,000 households in New Hampshire qualify for the Lifeline services, according to TracFone, which provides the mobile handsets at its own expense.
"It's an evolution," said Jose Fuentes, director of government relations for TracFone.

The FCC approved the wireline to wireless expansion of Lifeline last year. TracFone now offers the service in 16 states.

Other companies in other states are leveraging wireless benefits via the Lifeline program, but Fuentes said TracFone is the only wireless company offering cell services 100 percent free to consumers.
"It's a necessity," he said. "Economic times are tough these days, we recognize that."

The cell phone offers in-demand features: voicemail, text, call waiting, international calling to more than 60 destinations and caller ID. With

TracFone, if a consumer runs over the allotted 66 minutes a month, they can add additional minutes through a pre-paid airtime card for the cell phone.

To qualify for Lifeline in New Hampshire, a household must participate in one of the federal low-income programs, including Section 8 public housing, food stamps, welfare, or if total household income is at or below 135 percent of the federal poverty guidelines.

Safelink Wireless will provide service up to one year, with one person per household receiving the free cell phone.
