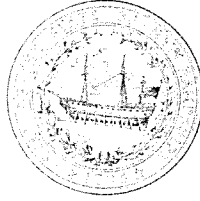

Dear Ms. Ranade:

On April 6, 2009, Evolution Markets submitted an application on behalf of Daymon Worldwide Inc. requesting certification of the Daymon solar photovoltaic facility (Daymon facility) as eligible to produce Class II renewable energy certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed the application and recommended approval noting that the application was complete on April 6, 2009.


Class II eligibility requires that a facility began operation after January 1, 2006 and that it produces electricity from solar technologies. The application indicates that Daymon Inc. has installed solar photovoltaic equipment with a gross nameplate capacity of 0.35 megawatts located at 700 Fairfield Avenues, Stamford, Connecticut and that the facility began commercial operation on December 31, 2008. The NEPOOL GIS facility code has not yet been obtained. Evolution Markets will provide the facility code to the Commission as soon as it is obtained from the GIS administrator. The ISO-NE asset identification number is not applicable as the Daymon facility is a behind-the-meter source.

The Commission has reviewed the Evolution Markets application and determined that it has provided all the necessary information to demonstrate that the Daymon facility is eligible for certification as a Class II facility. Therefore, the Commission hereby certifies that the Daymon facility is a Class II renewable energy source effective April 6, 2009 and is eligible to be issued New Hampshire Class II renewable energy certificates.

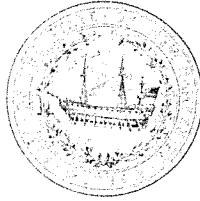

Please be advised that, pursuant to NH RSA 362-F, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified the Daymon solar photovoltaic facility as a Class II renewable energy source effective April 6, 2009. Accordingly, the Daymon facility is eligible to be issued New Hampshire RPS Class II renewable energy certificates.

Daymon Worldwide Inc. has installed solar photovoltaic equipment with a gross nameplate capacity of 0.35 megawatts located at 700 Fairfield Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut. The facility began commercial operation on December 31, 2008. The NEPOOL GIS facility code has not yet been obtained.
