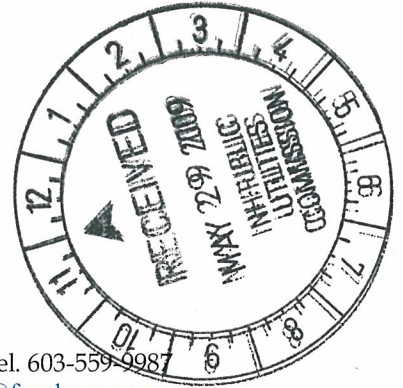


Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Complainant Clean Power Development, LLC (CPD) with regard to the process and procedure governing the resolution of the issues by the Commission in this proceeding.

Pursuant to Puc 204.04, CPD advised the Commission on May 5, 2009 that it was not satisfied with PSNH's response. RSA 365:1 contemplates that the submission of a petition or other proper pleading will ordinarily comprise the triggering event of a formal investigation under RSA 365:4. See, Order No. 23,734 (June 28, 2001) at 22.¹

Accordingly, CPD requests the Commission to commence a formal investigation under RSA 365:4.
