I'd note that Ms. Ross submitted a hearings examiner report on August 14th and, among other things, it recommended that we grant the intervention requests from BayRing, One Communications, CRC Communications, segTEL, Comcast Phone, BCN Telecom and Covad Communications; and she notes that there were no objections filed in writing or made orally at the previous prehearing
