Approval of Revised Tariff Pages

To the Parties:

On March 24, 2011, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (UES) filed a proposed tariff for service rendered between June 1, 2011 and August 31, 2011 for customers participating in the residential Time-Of-Use (TOU) and Critical Peak Pricing (CPP) or the C&I CPP pilot programs. According to UES, the proposed rates were in compliance with the Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission in Order No. 25,079 (February 26, 2010). In response to Staff comments on the proposed rates, UES filed a revised compliance filing consisting of Original Pages 73A-73B, Residential Default Service TOU/CPP Pilot Program and C&I Default Service CPP Pilot Program, Schedule DS- P.

An administrative letter noting compliance with Puc 1603 filing requirements was inadvertently issued by Staff on April 25, 2011. On April 28, 2011, UES filed an additional methodological change with respect to the revenue neutrality adjustment to fully resolve Staff concerns. The revised submission included substitute tariff pages for the pilot programs.

On May 20, 2011, Staff submitted a recommendation to the Commission in which it stated that the rate calculations underlying the proposed rates in the revised April 28th compliance filing are consistent with the Settlement Agreement.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission approves the revised tariff Original Pages 73A-73B as filed by UES on April 28, 2011.
