Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed please find an original and six copies of the Technical Statement of Richard C. Labrecque which describes the final calculation of the renewable energy service option rates, including the Class I and Class II Renewable Energy Certificate market prices that were used to establish the rates. In the Partial Settlement Agreement filed with the Commission on January 7, 2010 in Docket No. DE 09-186, PSNH agreed to file tariff pages no later than February 1, 2010 containing the renewable energy service option rates for effect May 1, 2010, accompanied by a technical statement explaining the derivation of the rates for the three renewable energy service options and a projection of the prices for Class I and Class II Renewable Energy Certificates that were used to establish the rates. This filing reflects PSNH's final request for approval of the following renewable energy service option rates for the period May 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010:

100% Renewable Service Option Charge:	3.532	cents per kilowatt-hour
50% Renewable Service Option Charge:	1.766	cents per kilowatt-hour
25% Renewable Service Option Charge:	0.883	cents per kilowatt-hour

Also enclosed are illustrative tariff pages containing the renewable energy service option rates listed above and a worksheet containing the incremental monthly bill impacts for a residential customer using 500 kilowatt-hours and a small business customer using 10,000 kilowatt-hours under the 25%, 50% and 100% renewable energy service options. PSNH will file compliance tariff pages after an Order has been issued by the Commission.

Copies of this filing have been provided to the persons on the attached service list.
