Pursuant to the procedures established for the evidentiary hearings in Docket DT 10-025, enclosed for filing are an original and one copy of Exhibit FP-30, which is FairPoint's response to the record request made at the hearing held on May 26, 2010 (Transcript, Day 3, p. 97). This exhibit is public and is being served electronically on the service list in this docket.

FairPoint Exhibit FP-30 is a compilation of the merger conditions imposed upon FairPoint in Docket DT 07-011 (the "Merger Docket") per the Commission's Order No. 24,823 (the "2008 Order"), the Settlement Agreement among the Joint Petitioners and the Commission's Staff (the "2008 Agreement"), dated as of January 23, 2008 (as amended and approved by the Commission in its 2008 Order) and the Post-Filing Regulatory Settlement - New Hampshire between the Staff Advocates and FairPoint, executed as of February 5, 2010 (the "Regulatory Settlement"). In this compilation, we have utilized exact language from the above referenced operative documents wherever possible.

Exhibit FP-30 has been prepared by FairPoint for reference and for convenience in an attempt to combine all effective and operative merger conditions governing FairPoint into a single source document. Under no circumstances did we intend to deviate from the terms of the respective operative documents. To the extent that a party determines otherwise, we simply would revert back to the operative documents at issue.
