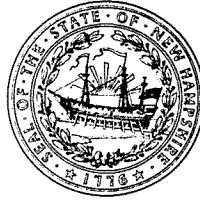

Registration as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Mr. Cournoyer:

On February 26, 2010, UMG, Inc. filed with the Commission an application for renewal of its registration as a natural gas aggregator together with a check in the amount of \$250.00.

The Commission has reviewed the application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that it meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02. Therefore, the Commission will approve the renewal application of UMG, Inc. as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, with the registration to be effective April 15, 2010, which coincides with the expiration of its current registration. The new registration will expire at the end of business on April 14, 2012.

Additionally, please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 (e), each aggregator applicant shall re-register with the Commission every 2 years by filing an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration, i.e., in the case of UMG, Inc., on or before March 15, 2012. Pursuant to Puc 3003.02 (d), each natural gas aggregator shall notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. 
Finally, there is currently no provision in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.02 which requires a fee for the renewal of the registration as a natural gas aggregator. Accordingly, the \$250 fee UMG, Inc. submitted with its renewal application will be refunded as soon as administratively possible.
