RE: Aggregation of Customer Sited Renewable Resources



Dear Ms. Howland,

The Commission has previously approved New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc ("NHEC") to be an Independent Monitor for purposes of the Renewable Portfolio Standards as defined in PUC Rule 2500. NHEC, as a Distribution Utility under that rule, desires to aggregate the Customer Sited Sources that have been certified as Customer Sited Sources when entering these resources into the NEPOOL Generation Information System ("GIS"). This will simplify entry and allow for the aggregation of fractional Renewable Energy Certificates ("RECs") into whole RECs. NHEC proposes to separately aggregate the resources by generation type (i.e. solar PV, wind).

NHEC seeks the Commission's acknowledgement and approval that this action would be consistent with its authority as an Independent Monitor and Distribution Utility within the 2500 rules.
