Dear Director Howland:

Please accept this letter as the response of Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern" or "the Company") to the October 18, 2010 Memorandum and Recommendations of the Safety Director ("Recommendations") in the above-captioned matter.

Northern has reviewed the Recommendations and has no objections. Accordingly, Northern hereby amends its request for a waiver from the requirements of Puc 505.07 from a period of five years to the Safety Director's recommendation of three years; the Company accepts that any waiver granted would terminate in the event of a change in corporate control; the Company accepts that it will be required to notify the Commission of any significant change in its testing practices or capabilities, such as pricing; the Company accepts that the Commission is reserving its rights to reassess, revise or revisit the waiver in the event of changes or development in gas metering; and Northern agrees that it will supplement its E-7 Report, filed pursuant to Puc 509.09, to include:

- 1) Meter address location, meter identity, meter type sent for testing;
- 2) Age of each meter tested; and
- 3) Exact number and class of meters tested per testing facility.
