Merrimack County Telephone Company concurs in the Verizon Telephone Company tariff for Private Line Services, together with any amendments and successive issues, for the purpose of providing private line services and channels within the Company's serving area and between the Company's serving area and other areas within the New Hampshire intrastate jurisdiction. This concurrence is limited to services that are at or below a speed of 1.544 Mbps. Any service requiring speeds above 1.544 Mbps will be provided on an ICB basis.

Merrimack County Telephone Company hereby expressly reserves the right to cancel this statement of concurrence at any time when it appears that such cancellation is in the best interest of the company, subject to the jurisdiction of the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission.

PRIVATE LINE SERVICE**DEDICATED ETHERNET SERVICE**

A. General Description


Dedicated Ethernet Service is a packet-switched network that provides a point-to-point or multi-point service arrangement for customers requiring special high-band-width data applications. This service is offered with various transport speeds ranging from 1.5 to 10 Megabits per second (Mbps) from one customer premise location to another customer premise location or multiple locations within the exchanges of the Company.

B. Conditions and Limitations

1. The service is offered subject to the availability of central office equipment and appropriate outside plant facilities. The service may not be available to all customers and/or at all speeds due to loop length, line conditioning and/or facility availability.
2. Customers must subscribe to this service for a minimum of one month.
3. Rates are based on term agreements. The rates are in effect from the time the service is installed until the end of the term agreement period. Upon expiration of the term agreement period, the customer may keep the same term agreement period or select a new term agreement period. Whichever term agreement the customer chooses, the rates for that term agreement will be at the rates in effect at that time.
4. Rates will not be increased by the Company until the term agreement period expires.
5. If the service is canceled by the customer prior to the completion of the term agreement period, the customer will be obligated to pay a termination charge. The applicable termination charge will be equal to the number of months remaining in the term agreement period times the monthly rate provided under the term agreement. Termination charges will not apply, if the customer replaces the service with comparable service and a term length that is equal to or greater than the original term agreement period.
6. The service may provided within an individual exchange or between exchanges of the same Company.
