Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,218, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected (over)/under collection for the 2011 summer period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through June and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations show a projected under-collection through October 31, 2011 of \$5,949 and would necessitate a \$0.0504 increase to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$2.1945, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$2.2449 per therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the revised rate of \$2.2449 per therm for the August 1<sup>st</sup> billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 25,218 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued April 29, 2011.
