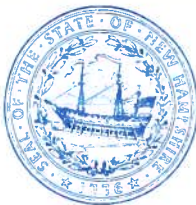

Dear Attorney Munnelly:

I appreciate having the opportunity to speak with you on October 8, 2012 in response to the letter you filed on October 1, 2012 in the above-captioned docket. The purpose of this letter is to confirm that People's Power and Gas, LLC (PPG) will address the remaining issues with PPG's proposed "Terms and Conditions" document. I also conveyed Staff's recommendation that PPG resubmit a complete application and you indicated that you agreed with the proposal and would encourage PPG to file a new application package.

In our conversation, we reviewed the sections of Puc 2004.02(b) "Provision of Information to Customers by Competitive Electric Power Suppliers" which were not addressed by PPG's "Terms and Conditions." I also suggested that you bring PPG's attention to the provisions regarding bill disclosure (Puc 2004.06), transfer of services (Puc 2004.07) and, specifically, Puc 2004.10 (a) which prohibits competitive electric power suppliers from including provisions in residential contracts that would waive any of the rights under Puc 2004.

Finally, in an electronic message, I informed you that there would likely be an issue regarding the financial security, which expires on March 10, 2017. Puc 2003.03(a)(5) requires the surety to extend for a duration of 5 years and 150 days. When PPG filed the financial surety on October, 2011, the term of the financial surety was adequate; however, with the passage of time, the term would not meet the requirements of Puc 2003.03(a)(5). As I explained, if it would be a hardship for PPG to obtain a new financial surety, please let me know and Staff will work with PPG to find an appropriate solution.
