Re: Renewable Default Energy Service Incremental Costs & Executive Compensation Reports

Dear Ms. Howland:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission are an original and six copies of the testimony of Stephen R. Hall. In this testimony, PSNH is requesting the following from the Commission:

- Authorization to recover through distribution rates the incremental cost of marketing and promoting PSNH's Renewable Default Energy Service; and
- A modification of the portion of the Commission's order in Docket No. DE 09-035 (PSNH Distribution Rate Case) that specified the filing deadline and time frame for PSNH's annual reports on executive compensation.

PSNH suggests that the most administratively efficient way to handle these requests is to include these issues in one of the dockets that will be or have been opened by the Commission in response to other filings made by PSNH which relate to Docket No. DE 09-035. Those filings are Exogenous Events (Docket No. DE 11-070); February 2010 Wind Storm Costs (Docket No. DE 11-082); and Step Increase for Changes in Net Plant in Service for the Period April 1, 2010 to March 31, 2011, which is being filed contemporaneously with this filing.
