On September 7, 2011, Stetson Wind II, LLC submitted an application requesting certification for its Stetson II Wind Project (Stetson II) as a Class I facility pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. Staff has reviewed the application and recommends approval (noting that all information required to complete the Stetson I project application in accordance with New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2500) was received on November 14, 2011.

The Stetson II facility is comprised of 17 wind turbines that began operation on August 15, 2008. The nameplate capacity is 25.5 megawatt (MW) of wind-generated electricity; Stetson II's output is transmitted to the Bangor Hydro Electric's substation in Chester, ME to bring the power from the wind farm to the electric grid. The application provides documentation that the project has met all the requirements of the State of Maine, Department of Environmental Protection. The facility's NEPOOL generation information system (GIS) facility code is MSS 16612; the ISO-New England asset identification number is 16624.


The Commission has reviewed the Stetson II application and determined that Stetson Wind II, LLC has provided all the necessary documentation to demonstrate that the project meets all the requirements of Puc 2502.02 and is eligible for certification as a New Hampshire Class I facility. Therefore, the Commission hereby certifies that the

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Stetson II wind facility is a Class I renewable energy source effective November 14, 2011 and is eligible to be issued New Hampshire Class I Renewable Energy Certificates.

Attached please find a copy of the notice of this certification provided to the GIS administrator. The New Hampshire Renewable Portfolio Standard certification code for the Stetson II facility is NH-I-11-036.

Pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has certified Stetson Wind II, LLC's application for Class I eligibility of its Stetson Wind II Project (Stetson II) as a Class I facility, effective November 14, 2011. Stetson II consists of 17 wind turbines that began operation on August 15, 2008. The nameplate capacity is 25.5 megawatt (MW) of wind-generated electricity. The facility is located on Stetson Mountain, 1650 Power Alley in an unorganized township in Maine and falls under the jurisdiction of the Land Use Regulation Commission. The area is identified as T8R3 NBPP.

Stetson II's output is transmitted to the Bangor Hydro Electric's substation in Chester. The facility's NEPOOL generation information system (GIS) facility code is MSS 16612. The applicant's ISO-New England asset identification number is 16624. The facility's New Hampshire certification code is NH-II-11-036.
