On December 14, 2011, following a hearing on temporary rates and other items, Staff and the parties to the above-captioned docket met in a technical session. On December 15, 2011, Staff filed a report stating that the parties had agreed that questions on the scope of the docket – in particular whether a full rate case was necessary – required rulings from the Commission prior to further proceedings in the case. On December 28, 2011, the Commission issued Order No. 25,308, and concluded that a full rate case was not necessary. The Commission, therefore, directed the parties to reconvene to discuss and propose a new procedural schedule for the balance of the proceeding and to report back to the Commission no later than January 20, 2012.
