Please accept this letter as the request of Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern") for an extension of time to file its Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP").

Pursuant to the Public Utilities Commission's ("Commission") Order No. 25,641 in Docket DG 11-290, Northern is required to file its next IRP on or before December 31, 2014. While Northern has worked diligently on this filing, the Company needs additional time to complete its analysis and perform an internal review.
