On January 13, 2006, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 24,577 in Docket No. DE 05-126, which among other things, approved Granite State Electric Company's solicitation process for procuring default service supply for its Small Customer Group and its Large Customer Group.
