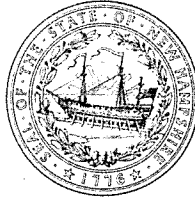

Dear Ms. Beebe:

On March 06, 2012, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from SREC Generating Company, Inc. on behalf of the Steuben Landfill requesting certification for the electrical production from Steuben Landfill's methane gas burning generation facility as a Class I renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law.

Staff has reviewed your application and has noted that at this time the Steuben Landfill has not obtained an ISO-New England asset identification number or a GIS facility code. Until this information is submitted, the Commission has no way to verify that the Steuben Landfill will generate electricity for ISO- New England. Until this information is provided to the Commission, we will not be able to approve your application.

Submission of the above information must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it cannot be processed. If the requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days of the date of this letter, your application will be denied without prejudice. Please refer to docket number **DE 12-059** in all future correspondence with the Commission.

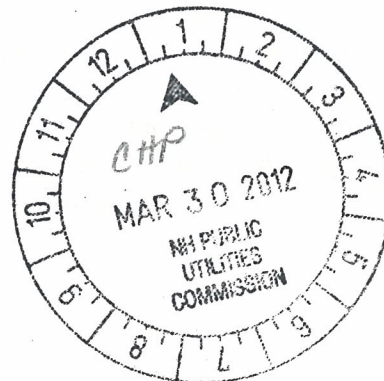
