17. By filing this application, you acknowledge the duties of an independent monitor shall be:

- (1) To perform an initial inspection of a customer-sited source's meter for accuracy and capability to measure the power produced, unless the meter is owned by a distribution company that has

already inspected it pursuant to Puc 305;

- (2) To measure annually the source's electricity production or displacement used to qualify for renewable energy certificates pursuant to Puc 2505.10 or Puc 2505.11;
- (3) To report the production or displacement of electricity service to the customer and the Commission annually, no later than January 31 for the preceding calendar year; and
- (4) To perform the inspection of customer-sited projects pursuant to Puc 2507.04(h).

18. An independent monitor shall not receive compensation for monitoring services that is a function of the number of certificates issued to any source using the monitor.

19. A monitor shall provide the Commission with notice prior to discontinuing services as a monitor.

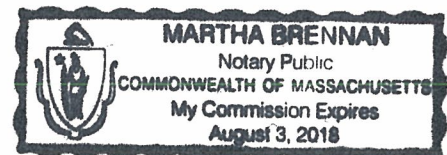

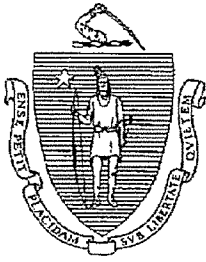

This letter is to confirm that, on September 14, 2010, the Department approved your request to be the Independent Verifier (a.k.a., "Independent Third Party Meter Reader," as provided in 225 CMR 14.05(1)(c)) for One Oak Hill Road PV, a Generation Unit in Fitchburg, MA, with an RPS ID# of SL-1057-06 and a NEPOOL GIS Asset ID of NON-32597. The Department determined that you have the necessary qualifications, as well as the required independence from the Owner and Operator of the Unit, as evidenced by your request and supporting materials received here on September 9, 2010.
