Summary

On February 27, 2014, the Commission received an application filed by Power House Systems requesting Class II New Hampshire Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) eligibility for the 0.044 megawatt (MW) Weston Dam Solar photovoltaic (PV) array that will be part of the Andrew Locke – Hydro Management Group's (Hydro Management Group) approved aggregation pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission, in a non-adjudicative process, is required to issue a determination of whether a facility meets a particular classification within 45 days of receipt of a completed application. The above-named facility is a customer-sited source and meets the Class II eligibility requirements under RSA 362-F:4, II. Based on review of the application Staff recommends Commission approval for Weston Dam Solar as an eligible Class II facility to be included in the Hydro Management Group aggregation, effective as of February 27, 2014.

Analysis

To qualify as a REC eligible facility, Puc 2505.08 (b) requires the source to provide the following information:

This facility is a customer-sited source and its output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor pursuant to Puc 2509.09. The application states that William Short, Energy Audits Unlimited, will monitor the output of this facility and will report the facility's output quarterly to the NEPOOL Generation Information System and annually to the customer and the Commission as part of the Hydro Management Group's Class II aggregation pursuant to N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08 and 2505.09.

## Recommendation

Staff has reviewed the application for the Weston Dam Solar PV array and participation in the Hydro Management Group aggregation and can affirm it is complete pursuant to Puc 2505.08. Staff has determined that this facility meets the requirements for certification as a Class II renewable energy source. Further, Staff recommends Commission approval for Weston Dam Solar as an eligible Class II facility to be included in the Hydro Management Group aggregation, effective as of February 27, 2014.
