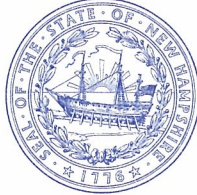

Dear Ms. Howland:

The Commission held a hearing in this matter on February 28, 2013 and at that hearing, the Commission directed Staff to assist Mr. Lake, an intervenor, in filing certain documents he wished to have placed into evidence. At the time of the hearing, Mr. Lake had been uncertain which documents to place into evidence and wanted time to review the documents and make a decision. Earlier this week, Staff spoke with Mr. Lake and Mr. Lake stated he would prefer to have the benefit of reviewing the hearing transcript prior to deciding which documents he wanted placed into evidence. Staff is aware that the transcript may take up to two weeks post-hearing to be completed.
