Dear Ms. Howland:

On December 10, 2013, Granite State Electric Company d/b/a/Liberty Utilities requested the ability to transfer funds within the residential sector of its Core electric energy efficiency programs to meet 2013 year-end demand for its ENERGY STAR®Homes program. Liberty Utilities expects to under-spend in its Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® program and ENERGY STAR® Appliance program and wishes to transfer from those programs \$35,000 and \$20,000, respectively, to the ENERGY STAR® Homes program. This budget transfer represents more than 20% of the approved budget and, therefore, the company is filing the budget transfer request with the Commission in accordance with Section I (K) of the Commission-approved 2013-2014 Core program.¹

Staff supports the proposed transfer. Absent any comments to the contrary by any interested party within two weeks of the filing, and absent Commission notification within 30 days of the need to conduct an in-depth review, Staff believes the transfer will be deemed approved per Section I (K).
