I am writing on behalf of PNE Energy Supply LLC d/b/a **Power New England** ("PNE") with **respect to the Commission's Order No. 25,468 (March 5, 2013)**.

In the Order, the Commission the Commission stated that PNE would not be able to "participate unless and until it is reinstated as a qualified market participant in the ISO-NE market."

Effective April 11, 2013, PNE has regained access to ISO-NE administered wholesale markets. Accordingly, PNE intends to participate in the proceeding as the Petitioner.

As soon as the Commission issues its Order in DE 13-060, PNE intends to make a compliance filing providing documentation of this matter.
