- Transition- As of the effective date of this tariff, any DS3 dedicated transport element that a TC leased prior to the effective date of this tariff from the Telephone Company between any Tier 1 and/or Tier 2 wire centers set forth in Part B Section 21, but which the Telephone Company is not obligated to unbundle pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 51.319(e)(2)(iv)(A), shall be available for lease from the Telephone Company at a rate equal to 115 percent of the rate set forth in Part M, Section 2.2.1 of this tariff for the DS3 dedicated transport network element for a period of 7 months.
