Dear Mr. Sharp:

On January 24, 2013, Town Square Energy, LLC (Town Square) submitted an application with the Commission to register as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). On May 20, 2013, Town Square requested an extension for its application review period and, on May 31, 2013, the Commission granted the extension, until June 1, 2013. The application is incomplete and does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003. In particular, Staff of the Commission reviewed the filing and identified the following item which is missing from the application.

1) Proof of financial surety with an expiration date not less than 5 years and 150 days after the initial application is filed.

Puc 2003.01(d)(4) Evidence of financial surety, as defined in Puc 2003.03.

Regarding item #1, the Commission has received your filing of a surety bond with a term that expires upon 30-days prior written notice of termination and your request for a waiver of N.H. Code of Admin. Rule Puc 2003.03(a)(5). If the Commission grants

your request for a waiver, then your application will be considered complete. At that time, the Commission will commence review of your application.
