Deficiency Letter

Dear Mr. Schieffelin:

On March 1, 2013, First Point Power, LLC submitted an application with the Commission to register as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). The application is incomplete and does not comply with the requirements of N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003. In particular, Staff of the Commission reviewed the filing and identified the following item which is missing from the application.

1) Proof of financial surety with an expiration date not less than 5 years and 150 days after the initial application is filed.

Puc 2003.01(d)(4) Evidence of financial surety, as defined in Puc 2003.03.

Regarding item #1, the Commission has received your filing of a surety bond with a 1year term and request for a waiver of the 5-year 150-day minimum term requirement stated in N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2003.01(d)(4). Staff expects the Commission to address your request for a waiver first. If the waiver is granted, then your application will be deemed complete. Once your application is deemed complete, the Commission will consider whether to approve the application.
