
You attended a public comment hearing and a technical session yesterday on behalf of New Hampshire Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NHEC) in the above-captioned docket. As you know, the Puc 300 Rules for Electric Service contain a provision which identifies the limited provisions of the rules that are intended to apply to the NHEC. Puc 301.01(b).

In addition to those provisions, Staff stated at the public comment hearing that it recommends that the following additional provisions be applicable to the NHEC: Puc 306.09, Emergency Response Standards; Puc 307.10 Tree-Trimming Standards; Puc 311, Transfer of Service by Utility of Customers Returning to Utility Energy Supply; and Puc 306.10, a proposed new provision on Physical and Cyber Security Plans and Reporting.

To accept Staff's recommendation, the Commission will have to approve the inclusion of the above reference provisions in Puc 301.01 in the final proposal.

As noted in the Order of Notice, all parties have until November 13, 2013 to file additional public comments.
