





## Notice of Pre-Hearing Conference Petition for Increase in Rates PENNICHUCK WATER WORKS, INC. Docket No. DW 13-130 July 17, 2013 10:00 AM

Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) has petitioned the New Hampshire  
Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of an increase to  
its rates. PWW has asked for an overall permanent increase of 0.12%  
and that current rates be made temporary. PWW's request is based on  
increases in its operating costs as well as investment in its plant and  
treatment systems to ensure continued compliance with the Safe Drink-  
ing Water Act. The increase would apply to all customers. The increase  
for PWW residential general metered customers would be as follows:

the Commission's Offices in Concord on July 17, 2013 at 10:00 AM. At  
the Pre-hearing Conference, the Commission will hear preliminary state-  
ments from PWW and other parties, and will consider requests for formal  
intervener status.

The Pre-Hearing Conference is open to the public. Customers and  
other interested parties are invited to attend the hearing and comment on
