Dear Mr. Kalet:

On December 16, 2013 the Commission received your letter requesting the transfer of REC eligibility for your residential photovoltaic array, from the Solar Farm Bank aggregation to the Knollwood Energy aggregation, pursuant to Puc 2505.12. The Commission originally certified the Kalet 0.0043 megawatt photovoltaic array as a Class II renewable energy source effective October 03, 2013. The facility's New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is now NON 38850.

Knollwood Energy was approved as an aggregator of New Hampshire customer-sited sources on November 12, 2013, pursuant to Puc 2506. The New England Power Pool Generation Information System (NEPOOL – GIS) has approved Knollwood Energy under project #14625.

Since the facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, its output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Paul Button will continue to monitor the facility's output as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has reviewed the request for transfer of REC eligibility and recommends approval of the transfer. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby approves the transfer of the Kalet photovoltaic array to the Knollwood Energy aggregation effective December 16, 2013.
