Dear Mr. Flanagan:

On October 6, 2014 the Commission received an email from Knollwood Energy of MA, LLC (Knollwood Energy) on your behalf. Attached to the email was a letter you signed requesting the transfer of renewable energy certificate (REC) eligibility for the Mark Flanagan photovoltaic (PV) array, from Solar Farm Bank, LLC (SFB), (NON 35889), to the Knollwood Energy aggregation, pursuant to Puc 2505.12. The Commission originally certified the output from your photovoltaic array as a Class II renewable energy source effective as of October 23, 2013.

The nameplate capacity of the PV array is 0.006 megawatts; the facility's new New England Power Pool (NEPOOL) Generation Information System facility code is NON 43300. Knollwood Energy was approved as an aggregator of New Hampshire customer-sited sources effective as of September 13, 2013, pursuant to Puc 2506.

Since the facility is a customer-sited source, its output is not recorded in the NEPOOL Market Settlement System and, as a result, its output must be monitored and verified by an independent monitor. Paul Button will continue to monitor the facility's output as required by the New Hampshire Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2505.08(b)(5).

Staff has reviewed the request for transfer of REC eligibility and recommends approval of the transfer. Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission hereby approves the transfer of renewable energy certificate (REC) eligibility for the Mark Flanagan PV array from SFB to the Knollwood Energy aggregation, pursuant to Puc 2505.12.

Attached please find a copy of the notice of this transfer provided to the GIS administrator.
