On October 29, 2013, Consolidated Edison Solutions, Inc. (ConEdison Solutions) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). In particular, Commission Staff reviewed the filing and identified the following item which is missing from the application.

(20) A copy of each contract to be used for residential and small commercial customers;

Regarding item #1, ConEdison Solutions' application, at item 12, states, "we may at times serve residential [customers]." Based on this statement the application is required to include a copy of each residential customer contract ConEdison Solutions intends to use.
